Good morning everyone! It has been a long week, but it has been a very good one. We have a lot to be thankful for and there is no place I would rather be this morning than right here.

Bridgette and I moved to a new apartment here in Springdale this weekend. We are excited to be a little closer to our jobs and the church. We are excited for the new opportunities we will have at our new home, and we are excited for this next part of our personal journey.

I want to thank everyone that helped us move our stuff. I really appreciate the kindness that was shown and the quick work we were able to do. Moving is always easier when you have a good group of friends and family to help. Thank you!

This morning in class we spent some time discussing Matthew’s account of when Jesus calmed the storm. This is probably a familiar story to many, but I believe there are still good lessons we can learn from it. Basically, Jesus and his disciples are on a boat when a massive storm comes and nearly sinks the boat. The disciples are scared out of their minds (as most of us would be) while Jesus sleeps in the back of the boat. The disciples ask Jesus to save them from drowning, to which Jesus replies, “O you of little faith, why are you so afraid?” In my opinion, Jesus sees a lack of faith in one or multiple of the following areas:

- 1.The disciples are unaware of or doubtful of Jesus’ true identity.
- 2.They could know his true identity but doubt Jesus’ power
- 3.They could doubt Jesus’ intentions, thinking he does not have their best interest at heart/doesn’t care.

I think all of these could be plausible, but the important thing is that their doubts are quickly put to rest. Jesus calms the storm without hesitation and the disciples are left asking themselves a very important question which happens to be critical for us to answer as well. “What kind of man is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him.”

We will inevitably have storms that will rock our lives or we will be able to witness storms in the lives of others. When we see Jesus climb up to the front of the boat, we need to ask ourselves if we have faith in him. Do we believe in who he says he is? Do we believe that he alone has the power to command the wind and the waves? Do we believe that he has the best of intentions for us? If we believe those things, I think Jesus will say we have great faith. What a compliment.
