# Youth Ministry Caleb Says...

Nov. 3 – Start of Winter Series, Din Din and Devo

Nov. 8-9 – Deeper Youth Conference

Good morning everyone! I hope your time at Robinson Avenue this morning is uplifting personally. I also hope that you can spend some time in prayer and worship to God!

This morning's youth class was the first of our winter quarter. Scott Ware kicked it off and Jimmy Allen and Nick Emerson will be teaching as well in the following weeks. Be sure to tell them thank you for their participation in the youth ministry.

I was surprised this week when I was preparing for our Wednesday night class. I was trying to see how much time the kids spend at church vs. how much time is spent doing school related activities over a given year. I wasn't surprised to see that the kids basically have a full time job at give-or-take 40 hours a week. What I was surprised to see was that if the kids came to all the youth events and church services offered over the course of 2019, they would only be spending a couple hundred hours less at church. I expected a complete blow out, but for youth group members who are fully involved, church is almost as big of a time commitment as school.

This creates a challenge and an opportunity which can apply to us as adults as well. When we are heavily committed to two different activities, we can compartmentalize. In the case of school and church, we are often encouraged to separate the two. This can be said for us adults with our jobs and church and even family life. We have these different things that can all ask us to be something different. When we compartmentalize our time, we compartmentalize ourselves. We end up being a different person based on where we are at the time.

Have you ever caught yourself living separate lives. Your church-self stays in its corner, your work-self stays in its corner, and your family-self is in its corner too. The peas and carrots must not touch! Does it ever feel like you're being ripped into three different pieces? In order to cover the rips, we put on a facade.

Jesus has something to say about this, particularly about not allowing our authentic spiritual self to govern everything else we do. Talking about the pharisees and teachers of the law, he accuses them of being white-washed tombs. They hid the fact that they were dead and fake on the inside by covering it with piousness. I pray that each of us allow our relationship to spill over into the other parts of our lives and bring life to all of them. We don't have to make the tomb pretty because we have nothing to hide. Every part is transformed and nothing is hidden away from the influence of Jesus on our lives.
