We want to especially thank Luis Soriano and Adam Guerrero for blessing us with their song-leading and preaching. It was moving to look around and see everyone who was present: some worshipping in English, some in Spanish, and still others in Lao.

Did you grow up in a church where they took attendance each week? Some small churches even called out the names of members to determine who was present and who was absent. I remember "roll call" in my childhood Sunday school classes. We had a chart on the wall and each week you were there you got a "gold star!" Many of us probably expect this practice to continue into eternity; we even sing about it... "When the roll is called up yonder I'll be there!"

We've been studying the book of Revelation in our Men's class (FUEL) on Wednesday nights. In Revelation 4-5 we're given a glimpse into the present Heaven. As the roll is called we get to see exactly who is present: The one exalted and seated on the throne (the lamb

(God himself), twenty-four elders (the redeemed), the four living creatures (all of creation), the 7 lamps (the Holy Spirit), the lamb who was slain (Jesus), and hosts and hosts of angles. What a scene!

We don't just come to church to get a gold star on a poster board chart – we come because we anticipate that one day we will receive a gold crown! We want to be here – so that one day we can be there. That's not to say that church attendance is the be-all-end-all of faithfulness, it's simply to say that faithful Christians want to worship and want to be with their spiritual family because what we experience when we come together is a foretaste of Heaven!
