These were men and women who were completely focused on being a disciple and teaching others to do the same. They were zeroed in, and that is inspiring when you read the whole story and see how hard Satan was trying to distract them.

In the midst of persecution, the disciples faced it with gladness because they were considered worthy of punishment for the Name of Jesus. When disputes rose up, they either resolved it or went their separate ways while still teaching the gospel. When opponents slandered them and their message, the disciples looked to the scriptures for truth. As false teachers arrived to spread inaccurate information about the gospel, the disciples defeated them with the power of the Spirit and his Word. With all of those distractions it would be very easy to take your eyes off of Jesus and his mission.

What distracts you from being a disciple and teaching others to do the same? Work, addiction, family obligations, money, etc. All of these can be distractions for us. They are to me sometimes. However, looking at the stories of these early disciples helps to renew my focus and my fervor for Jesus and his mission.
