**Scripture:** Hebrews 10:24-25

"And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

**Thoughts:** It has been really nice coming to services again this last month. It is exactly what I've been needing, and I imagine that it is the same for many of you. As we get back into the swing of meeting together again, I think there are a few things that we should do. As the scripture says, we should try and "spur one another on toward love and good deeds." Being together is very important! In our state's current health situation, we need to be careful when meeting together physically, but we can be present spiritually in all circumstances.
